Grocery shopping is needed for our 45 clients that qualify for \$50 in groceries per month. Volunteers stop at the office and pick up a list and a gift card, go to Meijer or ALDI or Kroger, get the groceries, call the person, deliver them and then drop the receipt back to the office. It doesn't take that long to buy \$50 worth of groceries! If you're buying your own groceries at the same time...it isn't a huge time commitment. This is also a great group activity for a small group. They can stop by and pick up six or so lists and then go shopping together. Groceries can then be delivered as a group or delivered individually to save on time. The Bible says to whom much is given much will be required...He's talking about us.

Our greatest need right now is drivers because of the snowbirds that leave during this time of year. I'd love to have four to six more people available for driving. All rides are all done on a case-by-case basis so it will fit in with the volunteer's schedule. Our clients just really need some one-on-one assistance: to get their coat on and get their front door locked and get down their steps and get into a car to get to the doctor's office, follow up appointments, to the bank, to the pharmacy, and to get lab work done. We want to treat our seniors with respect, and we don't want to have to turn anybody down when they ask for a ride.

Samaritan Caregivers is so blessed that we are a small local nonprofit, and we can be flexible and responsive as needed. We can offer no cost assistance because we use volunteers...like ACT3 participants. We utilize grant money and operating money for our office function and use volunteers to deliver the service. You don't really need a lot of special training to volunteer, you can just take whatever it is that God has blessed you with and put it to good use to bless others.

Volunteer Spotlight

In 2005 I felt God speak into me that I was to minister to the weary and broken. We had a special needs granddaughter born in 2007. I can't count how many times that we almost lost her. Then in 2014, our daughter was diagnosed with Stage 4 cancer. I kind of thought, "Lord, you've called me to the weary, but I am weary and am not ministering past my family's needs. Where's my ministry Lord, where's the ministry that you gave me." God reminded me of the scripture that he gave me, Isaiah 50:4 "The Sovereign LORD has given me a well-instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary", while I was working through the Journey Map assignment in the ACT3 Discovery Cohort. This brought back the vision and the beauty of Him allowing me to hold his weary ones. My coaching conversation really settled it in my mind that I HAD been doing His ministry in my family.

Since my husband retired, we've also been drawn to McAlister's to visit, pray and minister to those we meet. I think through the suffering that I've walked through in our families that I know what that weariness looks like and can see it in others. I see how crisis in their lives has just taken their joy... it took my joy, but I can say I've got my joy back. I really can't express it in words. I think the biggest thing that the enemy has taken from us, as believers, is our joy. We forget it's our strength. I just want to be faithful and let others know that it is okay to share our burdens. It's OK to be weary and to share that weariness with one another, but I also want to show them that there's a joy on the other side. If I can, in any way, encourage anyone, the glory belongs to God.

I've been recording hours with the trips I take with daughter for treatments, my time ministering at McAllister's, and Cross America's prayer group and Quality Control Room.



There are no words that can even express my gratitude for ACT3 and the words of wisdom spoken to me. As I enter my hours, it's an honor to say, "God thank you for using me because every day is a gift!" We have a purpose, and through this class, you can find out what your purpose is. I just want to say, "To God be the glory because he's faithful me, He is faithful to you, He's going to be faithful to our children and grandchildren.

"When the Lord blesses us, we have to share it. I think as seniors, it's during this time of transition, that it is hard to realize that we still have a purpose."
